John McGrath batted very well to make 58 runs, but the Dusties ran out of time and although making 6/203 they could only come away with a draw. 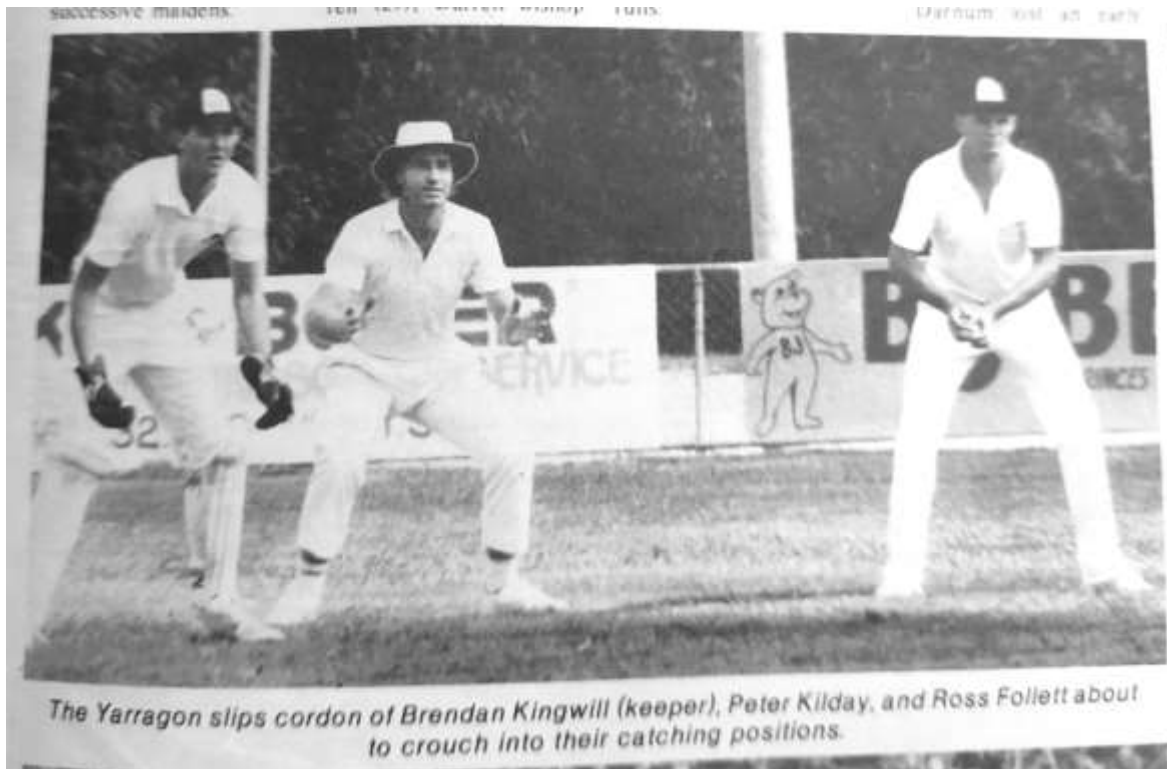

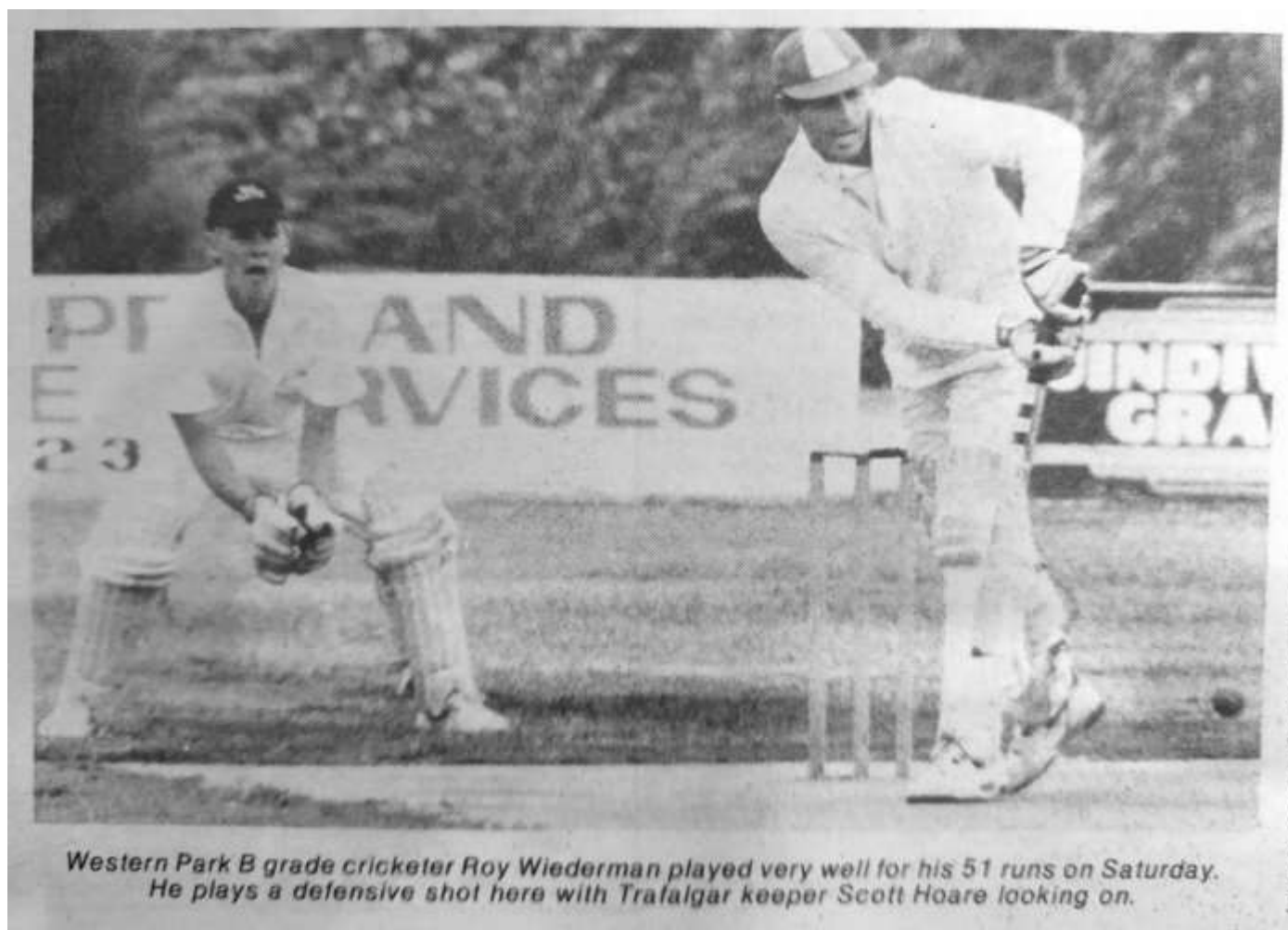

Yarragon, meanwhile are also well poised after already taking first innings points with Drouin and should press hard for an outright win against the young Hawks next week.

Drouin's first innings crawl was eventually laid to rest when they were bowled out for 37 off (29.3) overs.

Simon Mitchell top scored for the visitors with 15.

There were some miraculous bowling figures for Yarragon, with Paul Wheller's 3/9 off 10 overs and Jason Brown's 3/6 off eight standing out as the prettiest.
