Park Complete? – *From the Gazette (August 11th):* “The surface of Western Park is still causing problems, according to Cr Albert Farrington. In his Shire President’s report Cr Farrington said that work at the end of the season will hopefully complete the project and “restore the oval to the condition originally hoped for at the time of initial planning of the project.”

“The development of Western Park as the Municipalities major cricket and football venue continued to provide Council with problems,” he said. “The surface of the oval deteriorated badly during the 1980 football season, and while both football clubs were able to see out the 1980 season at Western Park it was obvious that significant works would have to be carried out prior to the 1981 football season. Council originally determined to carry out a major resurfacing project which would have resulted in the oval being unavailable during 1981. The two football clubs were concerned at having to vacate the reserve for a full year and at their request council modified the plans so as to enable the use of the ground for 1981.”

The surface of the oval was stripped, drainage repaired, the turf pitch removed, and the ground relevelled and resown immediately prior to Christmas 1980. “While it recognised the timing of the project was not ideal, particularly in respect to the resowing, a concerted effort by Council staff and representatives of the Western Park Management Committee resulted in excellent strike and growth.” Cr Farrington said. “Provided weather conditions are favourable for the remainder of the football season it is quite possible that a further maintenance project in spring this year will complete the project.”

Hoges to Lead West. Park – *From the Gazette (August 25th):* “Mr. Graeme Hogan, still recovering from two knee cartilage operations last summer is again President of the Western Park Cricket Club. Mr. Rohan Glen is Secretary, and they are backed by a strong committee headed by Vice-President Mr. John Kane, and Treasurer Mr. D. Trewern. The committee comprises P. Ross, B. Lemon, P. Croft, L. Pitt, M. Jostlear, I. Clark, N. Robertson, and S. Tweddle. WDCA Delegates are: J. Kane, G. Hogan, N. Roberston, D. Trewern, and R. Glen. The annual report was one of the most comprehensive ever seen in the WDCA.”

TURF PITCH GOES BACK AT WESTERN PARK

The turf wicket at Western Park, taken up at the end of last year because of drainage problems, will be reinstated at a reduced width of seven metres.

Warragul Shire Council decided to reinstate the wicket after a lengthy debate at council's meeting last week.

Cr Laurie Brown moved successfully that the engineering department cast out reports to the oval as an estimated cost of \$1800, the turf wicket be installed under expert guidance at a reduced width of seven metres, and that prior to the turf wicket being made investigations be carried out as to the possible use of the same soil used for the turf wicket at the Traralgon main ground.

Members of the Western Park Management committee and representatives of the user groups of the ground attended a meeting of council's parks and recreation committee to discuss what works were necessary for the further improvement of the surface of the oval.

At the meeting the Western Park Management Committee, the Warragul Industrial Football Club and the Warragul Football Club all supported the proposal by the cricket club to reinstate the turf wicket.

“It was generally agreed it would be necessary for it to be covered during the football season and for repair work to be carried out after each game.

At the meeting council received a letter from the Warragul Industrial Football Club questioning the possibility of reinstating the wicket.

Secretary of the club, Mr E. Green, said faith had been restored in the oval and a finals match had been played only this year.

He said it would be doubtful if finals would be played on the oval if the turf wicket was reinstated.

He said council should consider the matter carefully before making any decision with regard to the council and ratepayer financial commitment.

Cr Brown said council was already obligated to reinstating the turf wicket.

He said it was important for all councillors to remember the oval was designed for a wide number of sports including football, cricket and athletics.

“It is not just a football ground, and it would be possible to install a turf wicket and play football, cricket and other sports on the oval,” he said.

“If it is constructed in the right way with the correct supervision we should have very few problems.”

“After our meeting it was obvious all representatives agreed to our proposal so I cannot understand what prompted the letter from the Industrials Football Club,” he said.

Cr Charlie Brooker said he was totally against the turf wicket.

“This is not the right climate and even if it was it would be impossible to combine a turf wicket with football.”

“The cricket club could quite easily have a synthetic wicket and everyone would be happy.”

“If we allow a turf wicket to go in again we will end up with the quagmire we had at the end of 1980,” he said.

Cr Pat Gogan said council had previously agreed it would reinstate the turf wicket.

He said footballers would just have to learn to live with the turf wicket on the oval.

Shire engineer, Mr Ken Langdon said he agreed the oval must be used for other sports rather than football.

But council had previously tried a turf wicket and it had not been successful.

He said a turf wicket still could be damaged during the football season and the result could be another quagmire through winter.

Cr Arthur Hewson said the turf wicket should not be reinstated to the detriment of other sports.

He said the climatic conditions would not support a turf wicket and he doubted if the club would play a great number of matches on the wicket in any one season.

“I also consider the maintenance and even the construction of the wicket is beyond the capacity of most people in this area.”

“I believe it would be a backward step when there are many synthetic surfaces which would be ideal,” he said.

Cr Ivan Gray said council should defer any decision about the wicket for another 12 months.

“After we have carried out this new work and the oval has settled we should decide on the right type of wicket.”

“It is premature to make any decision at this stage,” he said.

An amendment by Cr Gray to carry out the work planned by the engineering department, but defer any decision on the pitch for 12 months was defeated.

An amendment by Cr Brooker to install a synthetic wicket was also defeated.

After Cr Brown's motion was carried a division was called for.

In favor of the motion were Cr John Crawford, Cr Kent Wilson, Cr Pat Gogan, Cr Ivan Gray, Cr Laurie Brown, Cr Max McCarthy and the Shire President, Cr Neville Cottrell.

Against the motion were Cr Brooker, Cr Hewson and Cr Bob Robbins.

School needs help

The Warragul Technical School Parents' Association has begun a campaign to raise \$5000 towards the purchase of a computer to be used mainly for student training but also clerical work at the school.

The association is appealing to local businesses for funds, and maintains that, because the computer is an integral part of most branches of business and industry, school-leavers need to be better educated in its use.

The recommended system, Micronations, combines a series of low cost microprocessor components to perform all the functions of a fully fledged computer, although not as quickly, and with less memory space. It has two T.V. keyboard terminals, but can be expanded to eight.

Total cost of the system, including software, is \$15 000. The Education Department has pledged a dollar for dollar subsidy to approved schools to a maximum of \$5000.

Thus, after direct donations from parents and the subsidy, the association has to raise \$8000. It has not taken out a bank loan because of the high interest rates.
