From the Gazette: "Western Park Cricket Club has set its sights on a WDCA premiership this coming season. The club has elected Ian Clark [as] President, Stuart Tweddle Vice-President, Neil Robertson Secretary, and Brian Lemon Treasurer. The committee will appoint captains for the four teams in the near future. The seniors will practice on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5.30pm starting next Tuesday, and the juniors on Wednesday's starting September 10. All practice will be at Western Park and new players are welcome. Nets will be completed soon, and members are asked to produce spades for posthole digging at a working bee next Saturday at 9am. Mr. Graeme Hogan as Social Secretary is planning many fundraising functions including Little Tatts. Winners so far are Rohan Glen, Howard Cropley, and Graeme Hogan. Western Park will play A-Grade and A-Reserve matches at Western Park (or at Warragul Tech when turf is unavailable). Subject to approval, B-Grade will share the Marist College No. 2 Oval with Nilma Dusties, and the juniors will play at the Tech Oval."

\$51 000 TO IMPROVE PARK OVAL

Warragul Shire Council will spend a further \$51 000 on the surface of the Western Park oval.

This is the final effort by the council to bring the oval to an acceptable standard.

The deputy shire engineer, Mr Gerry Prestney, told last week's shire council meeting that a detailed survey had been undertaken to determine existing grades on the oval.

As well, soil samples had been tested by the Department of Agriculture and had found unsuitable for use on the oval.

The department had made the following recommendations:

- That as the existing topsoil has proved unsuitable (both in laboratory and in practice) it should be removed and discarded. It should be removed over the existing drain lines until the coarse drainage filter material shows.
- The base to be graded on a suitable grade sloping to the existing drainage pipes.
- A coarse filter medium to be placed over the pipes and surface of the base.
- A free draining topsoil to be placed on top of the filter material. The depth of this topsoil will have a major influence on the quality of the surface. Minimum depth to be 100mm.

Mr Prestney said the council had three alternatives to improve the oval. It could top dress and fill the oval, removing a minimal area of topsoil, for about \$15 000, or it could undertake two different major jobs which would involve stripping off the worst areas.

These last two alternatives would be to increase the grade from one in 140 to one in 80 at a cost of \$67 000, or a lesser grade increase which would cost about \$51 000.

Mr Prestney said the use of the oval in the first 12 months would have to be restricted, and the cricket pitch would have to be levelled each weekend after football was played.

Cr Laurie Brown said that if the pitch was properly maintained, the slight increase in grade suggested by Mr Prestney might overcome the problems at Western Park.

He said the council had a responsibility to bring the ground up to standard.

Cr Brown said there was no chance of any cricket being played on Western Park this year, and the Shire President, Cr Albert Farrington suggested it was unlikely that football would be played there next season.

Cr Brown said he was concerned that so much would have to be spent on the ground, but the council had a responsibility to ensure that the oval was of a satisfactory standard.

He said it came back to a question of whether the council was prepared to spend \$51 000 to protect an asset worth \$250 000.

Cr Brown moved that the shire seek loan funds to increase the grade as in the \$51 000 alternative suggested by Mr Prestney.

Willow Grove To Leave WDCA – *from the Gazette:* "Willow Grove has withdrawn from Warragul and District cricket and will play in Central Gippsland this season. It was a surprise move after winning the B-Grade Premiership last season. However, the club has been under pressure for some time from CGCA-minded enthusiasts to transfer, and now it has happened. Although the loss of Willow Grove is regretted, the WDCA will start its new season October 4 with more teams than last season. It will have 10 in A-Grade and A-Reserve, 12 in B-Grade, and although Hallora have withdrawn, they may still field a team to make 12 in Juniors...Mr. Jeff Phillips is again President with Messrs Bob Mason and Charlie Pierrehumbert Vice-Presidents. Mr. Ian Clark is the new Secretary, Mr. Bill Pratt is again Recorder, with Mr. Ian Wallace the Junior Match Recorder."

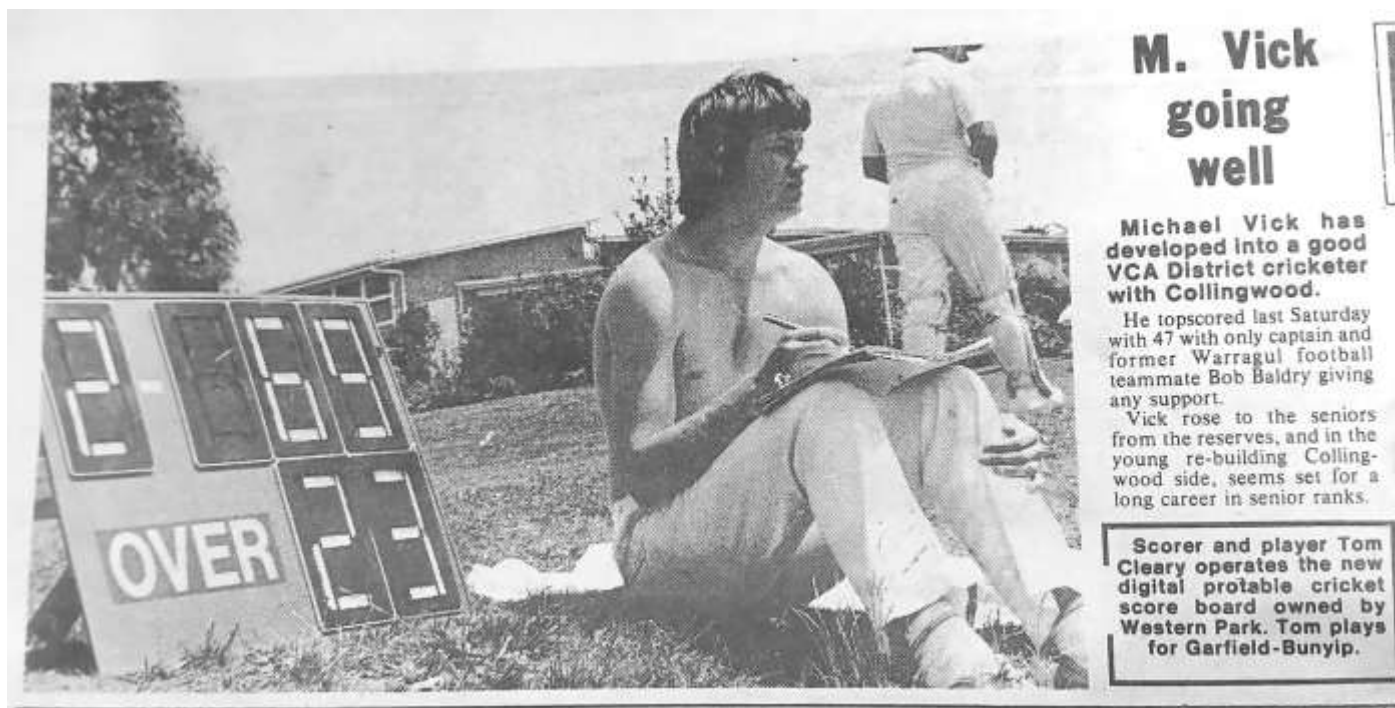

“Western Park – Dead or Alive? – From the Gazette: “WPC is worried by rumours that Warragul Shire wants to shift its turf wicket to Logan Park and install a synthetic pitch at Western Park. While no definite decision has been made, it is known that some shire councillors support this line of thought and seem to be lobbying the idea around sporting circles. Meanwhile work on improving the oval is at a standstill. There is no chance of cricket being played there this season and little hope of football next year or cricket before 1982 as the oval with its excellent outside facilities grows further into ‘white elephant’ status.

Maybe the idea of moving the turf pitch to Logan Park as an Association Oval is worthy of consideration. It would undo a lot of work by Western Park officials, but at least a synthetic wicket might give them home ground cricket. Logan Park No. 2 Oval (if fenced) could make the best turf wicket venue in Gippsland, but it is also rumoured that the agricultural committee wants it for showground cattle yard development. And so it goes on with rumours and speculation sweeping the town, officials talking about resigning and the sports oval that was to be the pride and joy of Warragul little more than a sick joke in the sporting world Let’s hope something develops soon to clear up this depressing air of uncertainty.”

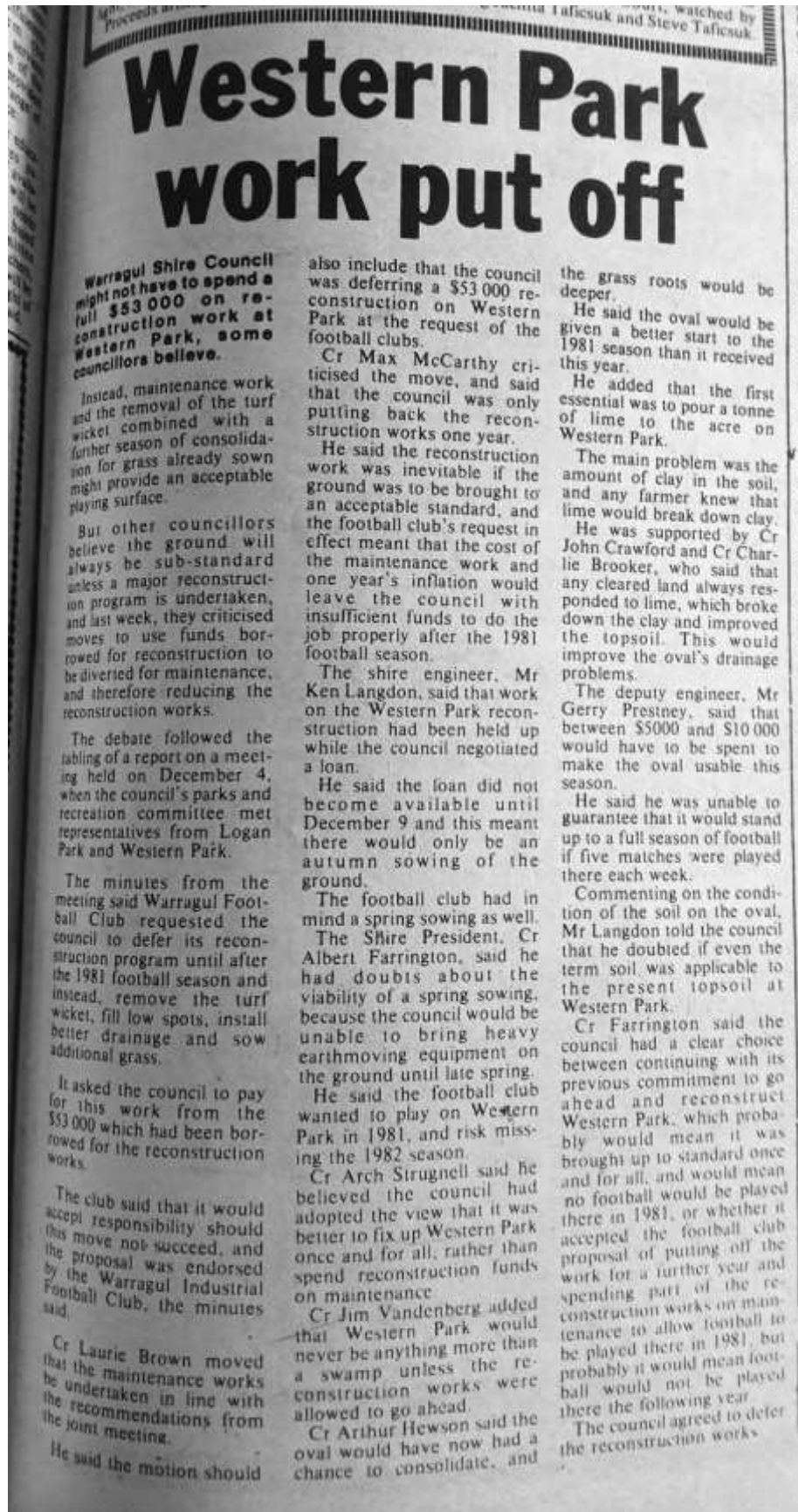

Western Park Causes Upset – *from the Gazette*: “Western Park broke the ice in Warragul and District A-Grade cricket on Saturday with a shock win over Trafalgar ([who are] third). Trafalgar are still third, but now in the shooting down range of Nilma Dusties, Garfield-Bunyip, and suddenly there Longwarry are (in equal fourth). It was a bad match for Trafalgar who were strangely reluctant to make an early start after rain the previous week. As events proved, there was plenty of time for cricket when play did start. Western Park – 8/157 at stumps – batted on to make 178 with Keith Alger getting the last two wickets to finish with 6/46 off 24 overs.

Western Park made their runs off 71 overs and then took only 37 overs to dismiss Trafalgar for only 103. Mick Jostlear and John Kane contained the Trafalgar openers and then when the batsmen realised the match could not be won, seemed to buckle under pressure, and Rohan Glen gleefully picked up four wickets to complete the rout. Western Park did the job so easily they even gained a bonus 15 overs for some second innings batting practice.”

Western Park Reconstruction Is Deferred – *from the Gazette*: “Warragul Shire Council has deferred a \$53 000 reconstruction program at Western Park. The deferral followed talks with Warragul Football Club and Warragul Industrial Football Club. Both clubs have told the council they wished to play on Western Park in 1981. The council has agreed to a request by the football clubs that it remove the turf cricket pitch and undertake some maintenance to improve the ground for the 1981 football season. This is expected to take up \$10 000 of the \$53 000 the council had borrowed for the the Western Park reconstruction. It means the council has less money if it decides to carry out reconstruction works in the spring of 1981...The Council only recently decided to borrow \$53 000, following investigations into the condition of the surface at Western Park.”
