They both punished the bowling with Wayne making 55 and Chris a terrific 89 before Rick Emery claimed both wickets. Bryan McLean (29), Rick Minichiello (a hard-hitting 57) and Peter Croft (32 not out) also contributed to the total. While all this was going on, John Cornwall was tragically run out without facing a ball. Rick Emery was the best of the Nilma Dusties bowlers with 3/81 off 20 overs and Robert Ballingall took 2/79 off 22. The rest of the bowlers got spanked with most of them going for six-an-over.”

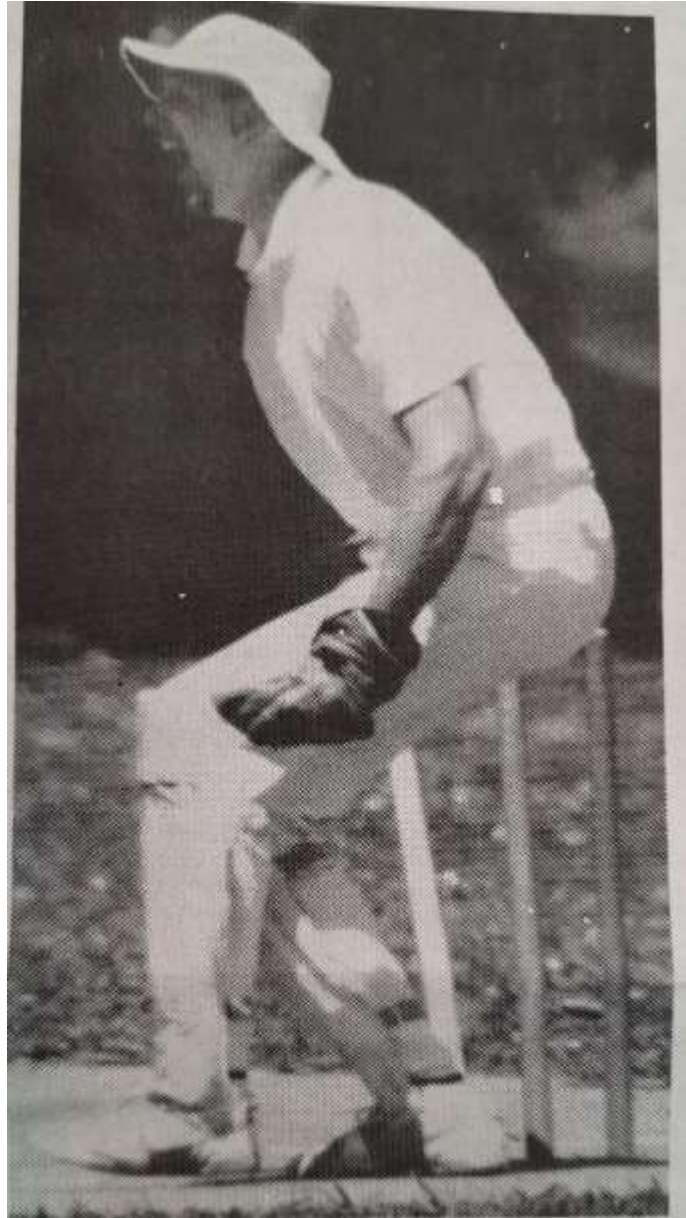

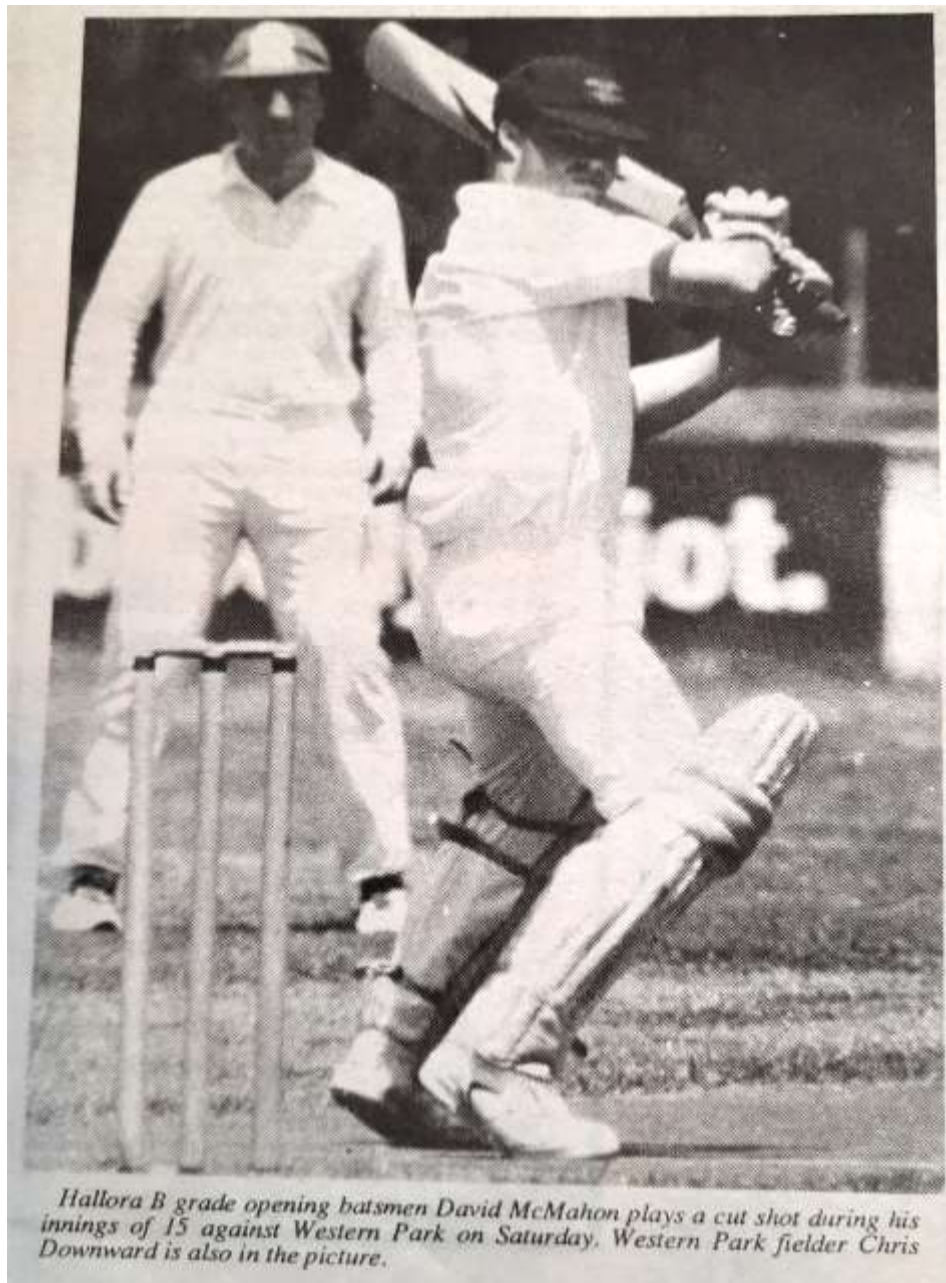

From the Gazette: “Drouin was sent in by Western Park and made the good total of 6/245. I would also like to congratulate Dave Boyer on winning the Captain's Award and also for his commitment, as he and myself were the only players to play all eleven games. Dave is a great bloke to have around, and he gets on well with all members of the team.

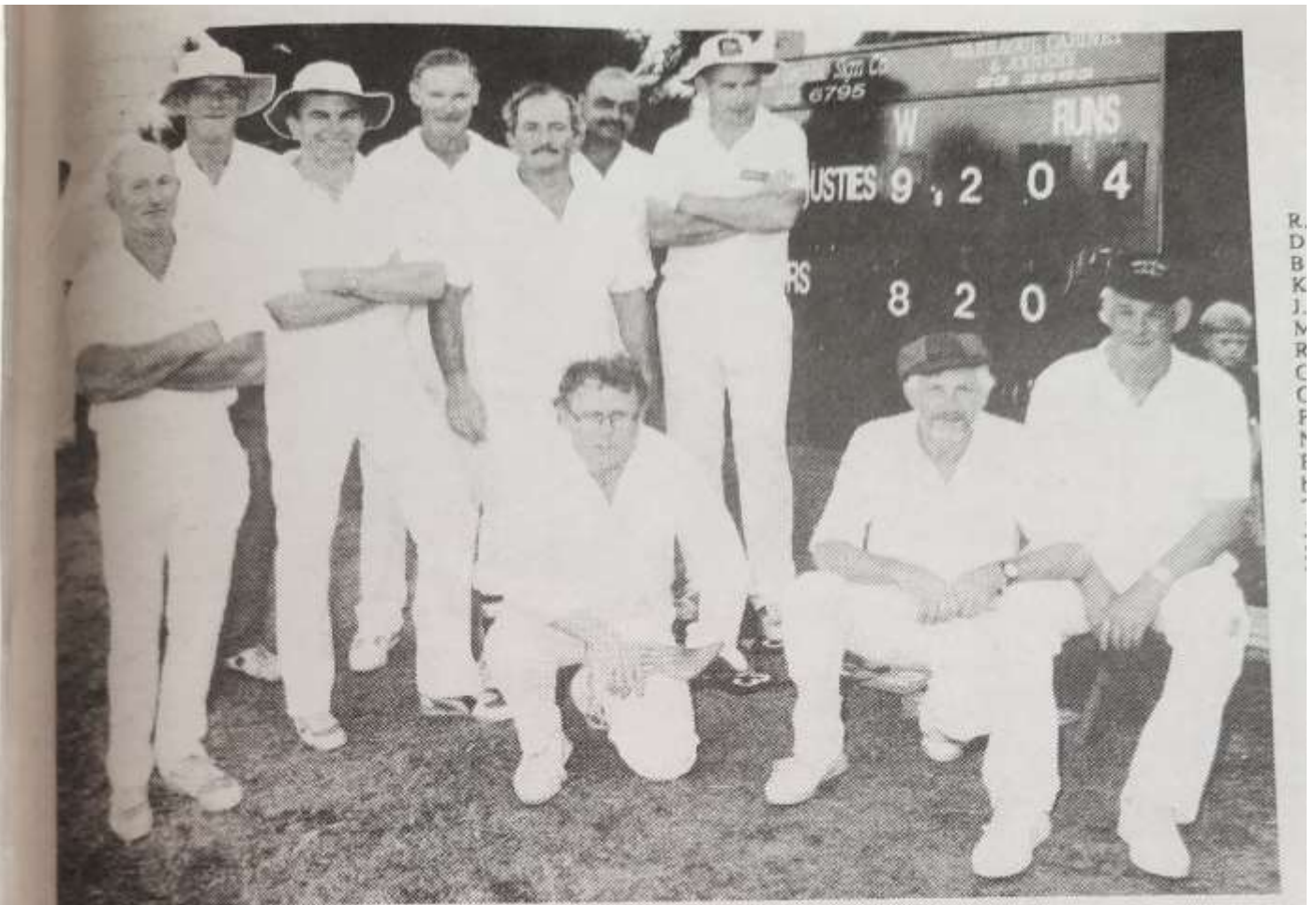
