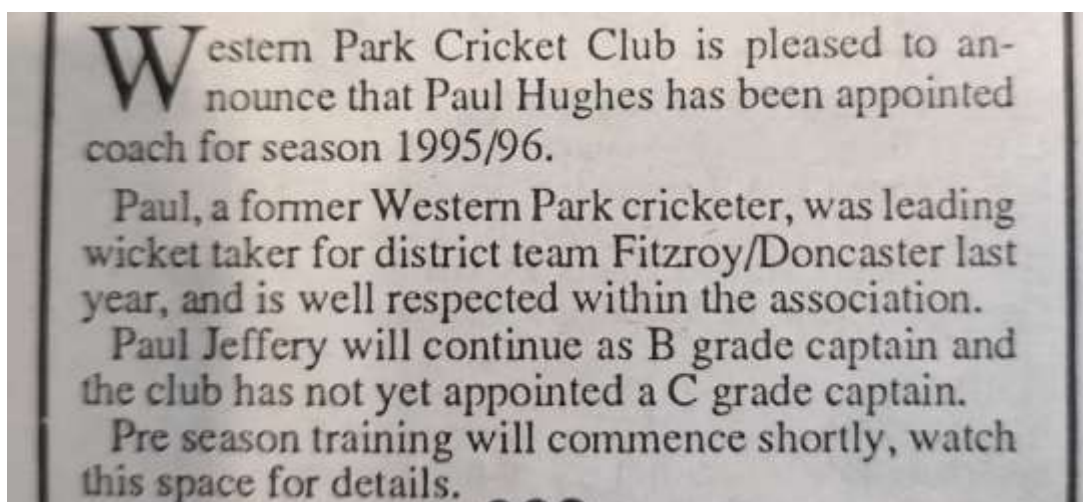

From the Gazette: "The ball is still dominating play with five bowlers taking six or more wickets in three of the five games played. The WDCA Executive copped plenty of flack over the decision to use the four-piece ball at the start of the year, but as it is, so far people's concern has been proven to be the opposite with bowlers totally dominating play to date. Drouin went down by 92 runs to Western Park after being bundled out for 178 at Bellbird Park... In Drouin's total Steve Clarke made 87 and was assisted by Paul Wyatt (34), but they were the only two who got going at all against the Parkers. Mat Ridgway redeemed himself with the figures of 4/68 with fellow opener and coach Paul Hughes taking 2/46, with Bryan McLean chipping in with 3/29 to give the Parkers the chance of winning. In reply they made 5/270 with a fifth wicket partnership of 135 between Chris Ayres (104) and Bryan McLean (48), with opener 'Jack' Naylor making 74 runs as well. Five bowlers for Drouin each took one wicket, with one of them being Steve Clarke who top-scored for them."

From the Gazette (by Scruffy): “Western Park A-Grade played Nilma Dusties at Marist-Sion with ‘Merv’ losing the toss and Nilma opting to bowl. ‘Jack’ Naylor (22) and Paul Gavin (54) got us off to a solid start. John ‘Chunky’ Pollard made a hard-hitting 45 with more expected of Chunky as the season goes. ‘Scruffy’ McLean finally put one together, making his first century for Western Park – going onto smash 154 with the last 50 off 20 balls. Peter Croft (29) and Mat Ridgway (13) also got runs, with the final score 9/335.

Dusties got off to a bad start in the run-chase losing two wickets for 22 in 10 overs, but the Horsford brothers got together and put on what so easily could have been match-winning partnership but with the run rate growing, wickets started to fall quickly, with Nilma eventually being 9/305 after 80 overs. Pick of the bowlers were coach Merv who from 32 overs took 5/86, and ‘Scruffy’ McLean 3/93 off his 21 overs.”

From the Gazette: "Once again 'Merv' called wrong, and Yarragon decided to bat on a track that offers nothing to the bowlers. A wicket in the fourth over had Yarragon 1/1, then a good partnership before Nick Mazza (47) was out had Yarragon in a solid position. From then on wickets fell consistently to see Yarragon all out for 137. Pick of the bowlers Peter Croft (5/40) and 'Merv' Hughes (3/35). Chasing 135, Western Park got off to a good start. 'Jack' (61) and 'Gavo' (19) set things up, 'Chunky' Pollard (30) and 'Spud' Ayres (46) saw Western Park to 6/178 declared. Yarragon asked to bat again batted terribly losing 8/49. No batsmen looked like they wanted to stay there long until Tony Kleeven and Alan Bowler – playing like a true tail-ender – combined to take Yarragon to 8/153 at stumps. 'Merv' (five wickets) and 'Captain Snooze' (three wickets) were the best of the bowlers."

From the Gazette: “What a week of cricket it’s been with clubs being fined for late payments, points taken off then reinstated, while an A-Grade player had his two-game suspension reduced to one after appealing against his penalty. Then the A-Grade match between Garfield and Buln was delayed by over half an hour because of a flash flooding between midnight and 9am on Saturday morning. But there were also some interesting results of cricket as well with some good wins, with some near misses, and one also sees that some clubs don’t want to qualify their players and opposition players for finals by not writing down their names on team sheets so that the recorder knows who actually played.

Third side Western Park were able to beat Ellinbank by 22 runs after scoring 7/170 off their 40 overs. A third wicket partnership of 99 by Chris Ayres (44) and Paul Gavin (54) was the mainstay of the innings but as usual Bryan McLean (20 not out) put the finishing touches on their innings with Wayne Naylor (12), John Pollard (13), and Peter Croft (16) all putting their hand up. Pete Felstead took 3/37 while Matty Sharman and Ricky Gray took one each. Peter Wallace top-scored with 53 while Greg Hayes (26), Peter Felstead (16), and Brad Aitken (18) were the only batsmen to show any resistance to the Western Park bowlers. Jason Hodder took 43/6 while Paul Hughes and Mat Ridgway took two and three respectively, with Bryan McLean taking the other one.”

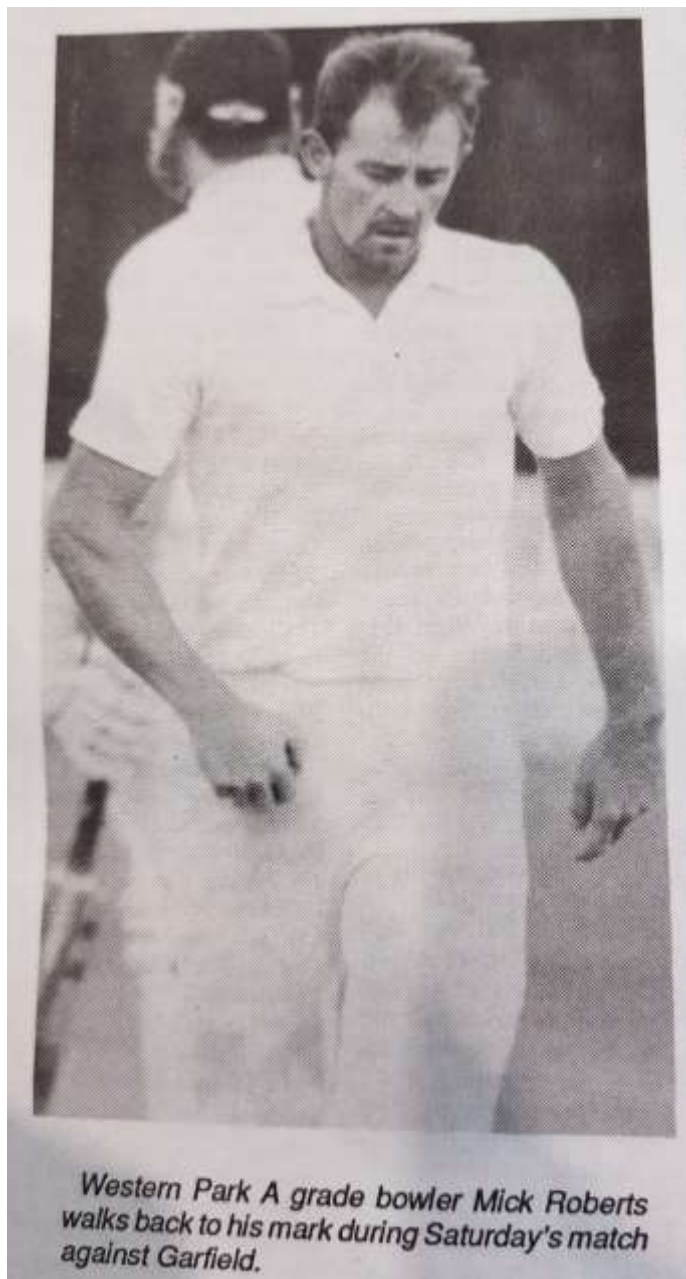

From the Gazette (by 'McDougal'): "Hopes were high at Western Park on Saturday that the Garfield A-Grade win drought might be broken. After an early stumble with the loss of Light for eight and Jamie Serong for seven, an excellent partnership of 73 between Mark Cousin and Dale Serong seemed to be steering the side to a possible victory. Serong was dismissed on 48 in somewhat unusual circumstances.

He hit a magnificent six over square leg which caused a lost ball and quite a long delay while a replacement ball was found. The interruption must have caused a loss of concentration as he was bowled first ball when play resumed.

Cousin went onto make a very nice 52, his best innings since returning to the club, before he too was bowled. Hopes were revived again by a solid partnership of 27 between Mick Preston and Cameron Newman. Preston was bowled for 18 and Newman run out for nine. Hopes were now fading as over 60 runs were needed for victory with only three wickets in hand. Matt Cunningham and Geoff Pumphrey got the show on the road again with a 30-run partnership and hopes began to rise. Cunningham was bowled for 21 and was quickly followed by Nathan Kenny for two.

The few remaining optimists were hopeful of a last wicket stand between Pumphrey and Peter Heywood, but it was not to be. Pumphrey too was bowled for 20 with the total 20 runs short of victory. It was a commendable total against a top side and was proof that Garfield A-Grade is not far away from being very competitive."

From the Gazette: "The match for top spot between Western Park and Buln ended in a comfortable win to Western Park by 116 runs after Buln were bowled out for 190. In the first week Western Park made 6/306 with Bryan McLean setting them up with a well-struck 97 with good support from Peter Croft (49), Chris Ayres (76 not out) and John Pollard (37). Good bowling by Mick Roberts (4/27), Bryan McLean (2/28), and Mat Ridgway (2/49) were able to keep Buln's reply to 190. 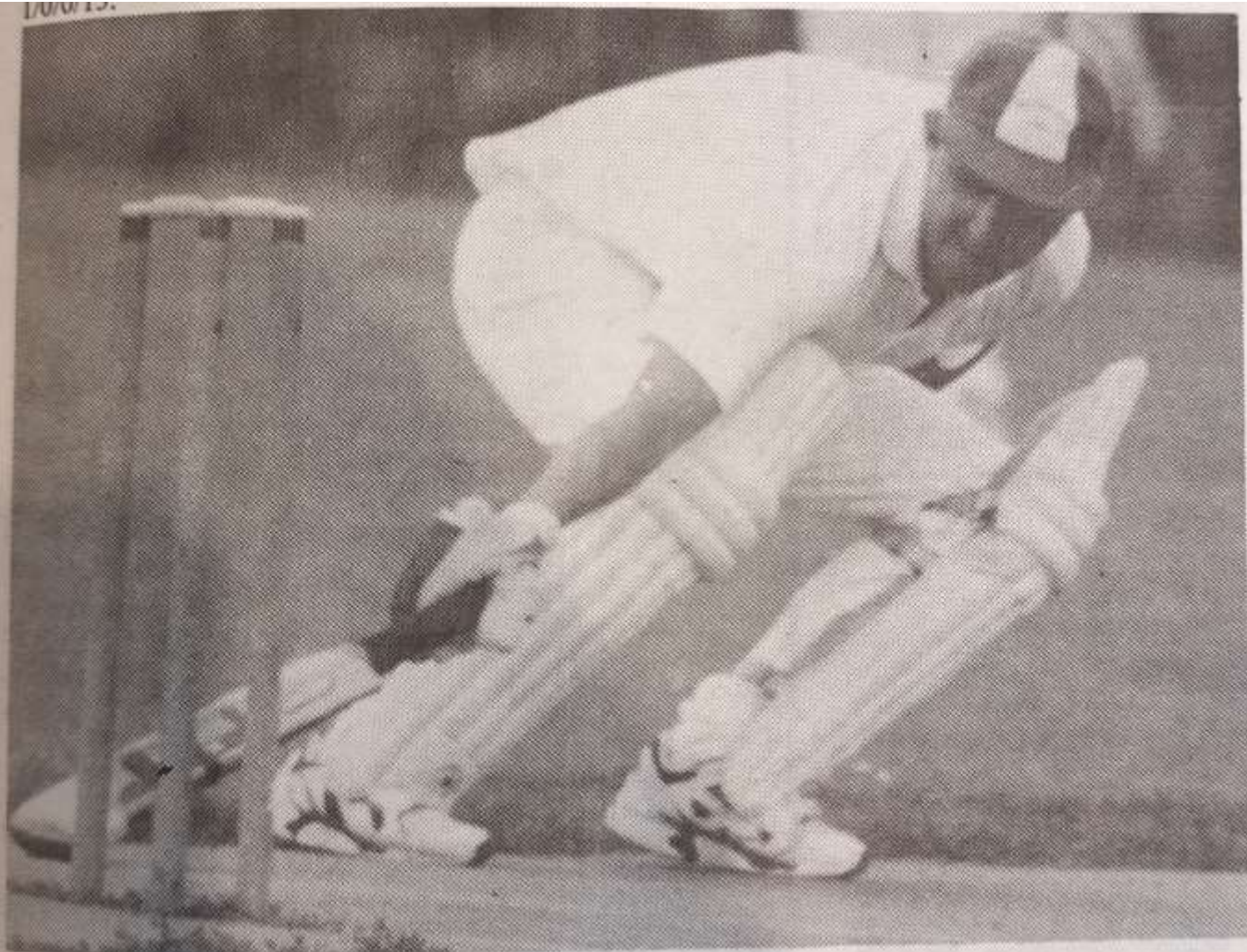

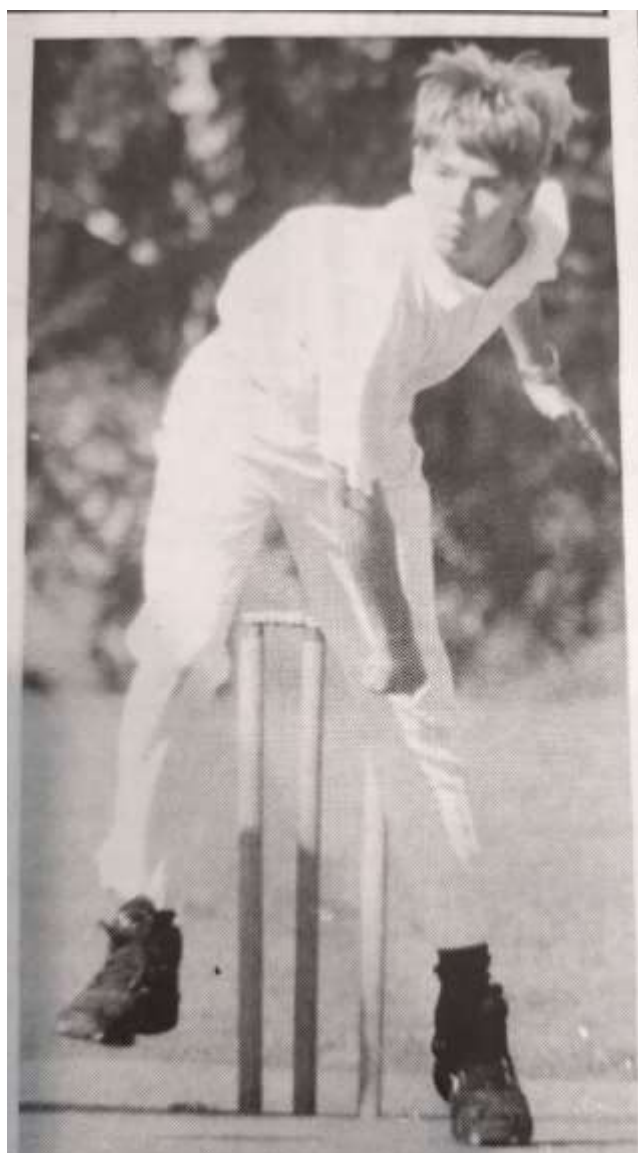

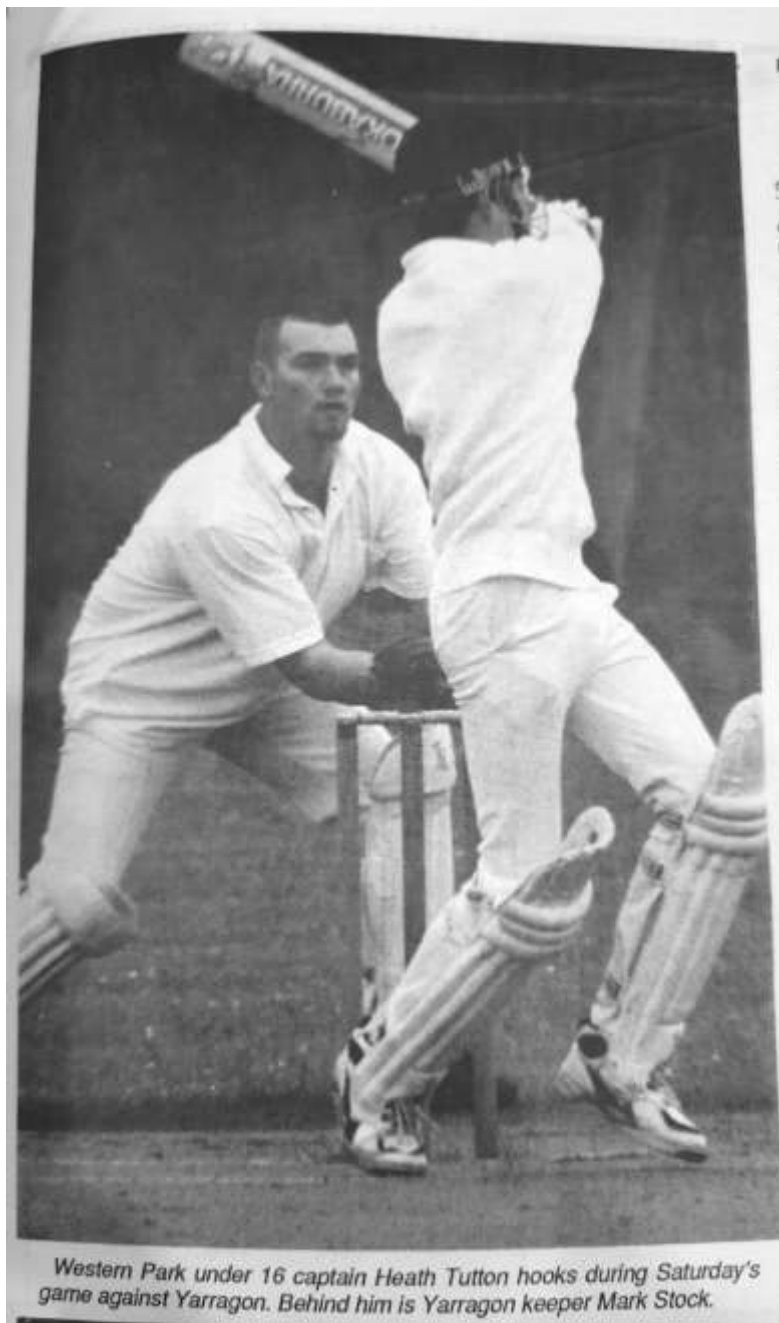
