*From the Gazette (by Trevor Gardiner):* “Nicho’s MegaSport Match-of-the-Round was the now annual first turf game at Western Park where the Parkers hosted Neerim District on Sunday, and a win was vital to both sides after some upsets the day before. Both sides made two changes with Paul Hughes and century-maker Danny Gleeson coming for the Parkers, whilst ‘Dick’ Emery and Adam Lennox came in for Neerim. Neerim District batted first with Captain-Coach Danny Sheehan once again top-scoring with 48. Matt Cumming opening made 20 whilst support also came from Scott Tymkin (31) and hard-hitting left-hander Ritchie Christian (19). Mick Roberts toiled gallantly with 4/24 whilst Rod Breeden took 2/46. Neerim’s total score of 6/142 was a handy score but with only nine players it might have been a little bit shy.

McCann and Lennox both did not attend with McCann being due to work commitments so all of a sudden, they were one bowler short – possibly two – let alone two in the field, but Craig Butler and 15-year-old Jamie Gleeson came forward and sub-fielded for them making the 142 more defendable. Western Park’s run chase was slow early with wickets falling at steady intervals with Rod Breeden (31) and Danny Gleeson (17) being their main scorers. With four overs to go Paul Gavin and Chris O’Hare gave them a slim chance of victory with 31 required, but when Brett Thompson’s second last over went for 15 runs all of a sudden victory looked possible even though O’Hare fell last ball of the over for 23. Tens runs became the new target after Sheehan went for six runs with two overs left and with four wickets left Western Park looked like winners. Thompson got Croft LBW second ball of his over, but another four runs came forward leaving six to win with one over to go.

It was Hughes and Gavin standing between victory. With three to win and two balls left Hughes went out caught, leaving Gavin to get three off the last ball, but the perfect yorker was bowled by Danny Sheehan leaving Western Park two runs behind Neerim’s total. Paul Gavin’s 38 was a captain’s knock under pressure and certainly showed once again what a great competitor he is. Danny Sheehan took 4/43 whilst Brett Thompson (2/32) and Mark Dibsedale (2/12) were the other major wicket takers.”

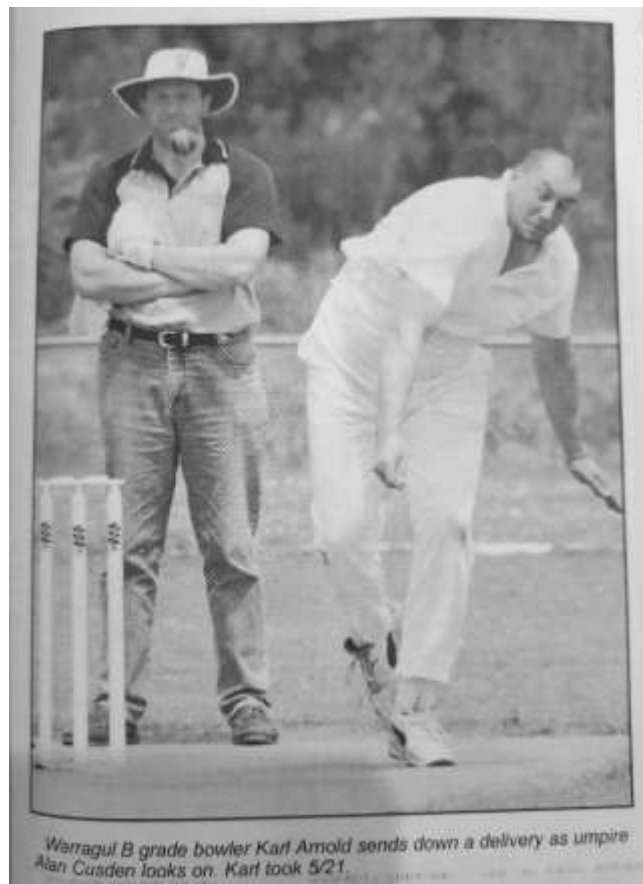
