At 6/51 it was a case of déjà vu for the Banker, following the debacle last weekend, but Cutler saved the day with a marvellous 56...Chris Masterson at 10 gave priceless support, contributing 31...Gary Pratt showed grit and determination at number seven with 31, as did Farthing who made 20. Paul Hughes finished with 4/44 from 20 well directed overs. It must have been a frustrating final hour and a half for Western Park, as it is for all fielding sides when held up by lower order resistance and was made much worse when it lost opener Ayres for one just prior to stumps, to be uneasily situated overnight at 1/3."

From the Gazette (by 'Peter Pipesucker'): "A sixth wicket partnership of 154 between Danny Gleeson and Mark Ridgway rescued Nilma-Dusties from a potentially embarrassing situation in the match against Western Park. Chasing a moderate 143, Captain Ridgway altered his batting order in an effort to run a few of the lower order players into form. However, the move backfired somewhat, and when Ridgway strode out to join Gleeson Nilma was awkwardly placed at 5/54. Certainly, there was still Rankin and Vick to bat, but there must have been just the slightest bit of tension creeping into the Nilma camp. It was quickly dispelled however when these two – not for the first time this season – steered Nilma-Dusties safely home. Ridgway finished with a swashbuckling 106, giving him centuries in successive matches. Obviously, he is seeing it like a football at the moment, which augurs ill for association bowlers. Gleeson made 73 in a welcome return to his early season form and relished the opportunity of adopting more responsibility at the top of the order. At stumps Nilma was 7/223 which gave them a comfortable win. John Laffy was the best of the bowlers and his 3/42 at one stage threatened to put the cat amongst the pigeons. Byers gave nothing away from his eight overs and was rewarded with 2/19."

By Tired and Emotional

The last WDCA round before the Christmas break was certainly a fortnight of contrasts.

Most matches were reduced to one day affairs following first day washouts and sweltering conditions prevailed on day two. Two A grade matches weren't sufficiently affected last week and were played out as two day games.

The match at Drouin was a fairytale affair, with bottom side Western Park recording an outright win against top team Drouin. Western Park resumed on Saturday at 3/66 in pursuit of Drouin's 91. Its batting has let it down repeatedly all season and when Drouin grabbed three quick wickets on the resumption of play, it appeared likely that the visitors were about to snatch defeat from the jaws of victory.

However, McLean had other ideas and he, along with the experienced Doug Holl, put his head down and they grafted their way to a magnificent win. Once first innings points had been attained, McLean threw off the shackles and began to play

his natural game which is to hit the ball hard. He finished with a fine 44, whilst Holl's 20 was an equally invaluable effort considering the context of the match.

Western Park called a halt to proceedings at 9/137 and threw the onus back onto the vanquished league leaders. Happily for all concerned, Drouin responded positively and regarded the declaration as an ideal opportunity of salvaging something from the wreckage.

Keith Alger took the Western Park bowling on right from the very start and his driving and hooking was a delight to watch. Last week's bogeymen, Hughes and Byrne, were rendered largely ineffective and skipper Ron Harper also chipped in with a cameo knock of 31.

This along with Alger's 68 enabled Drouin to race to 5/142 before declaring and setting Western Park the target of 95 in 16 overs, a difficult task in anyone's language.

Brimming with the confidence that victory brings, the Western Park batsmen responded ebulliently to the challenge and managed to snatch victory with just four balls to spare. Once again, McLean and Holl were the men for the situation;

the former completing a good double to be unbeaten on 38 and the latter 17 not out. Simon Byrne also played his part with a quick fire 22.

What can one say? The glorious uncertainty of 'proper cricket' was never better illustrated. God help us all if the appalling people running the game nationally ever get their way and abolish test cricket. Hanging would be too good for them. However, I digress.

The other game which was played as a normal two day fixture was that between Garfield-Bunyip and Nilma Dusties. The former resumed at 6/129 with its only hope being of able to keep Nilma in the field for a sufficiently long time to make a run chase impossible. It was not to be and the last four wickets were skittled quickly for the addition of just 13 runs.

From then on, there was never any doubt as to the result. Nilma Dusties must have just about the strongest batting line up in the competition and Saturday was no exception. Dairymple, who has been a little out of sorts with the bat recently, came good at the right time to make an unbeaten 67 opening the innings. Ridgway with 36 and Rankin, also undefeated on 49, ensured that the

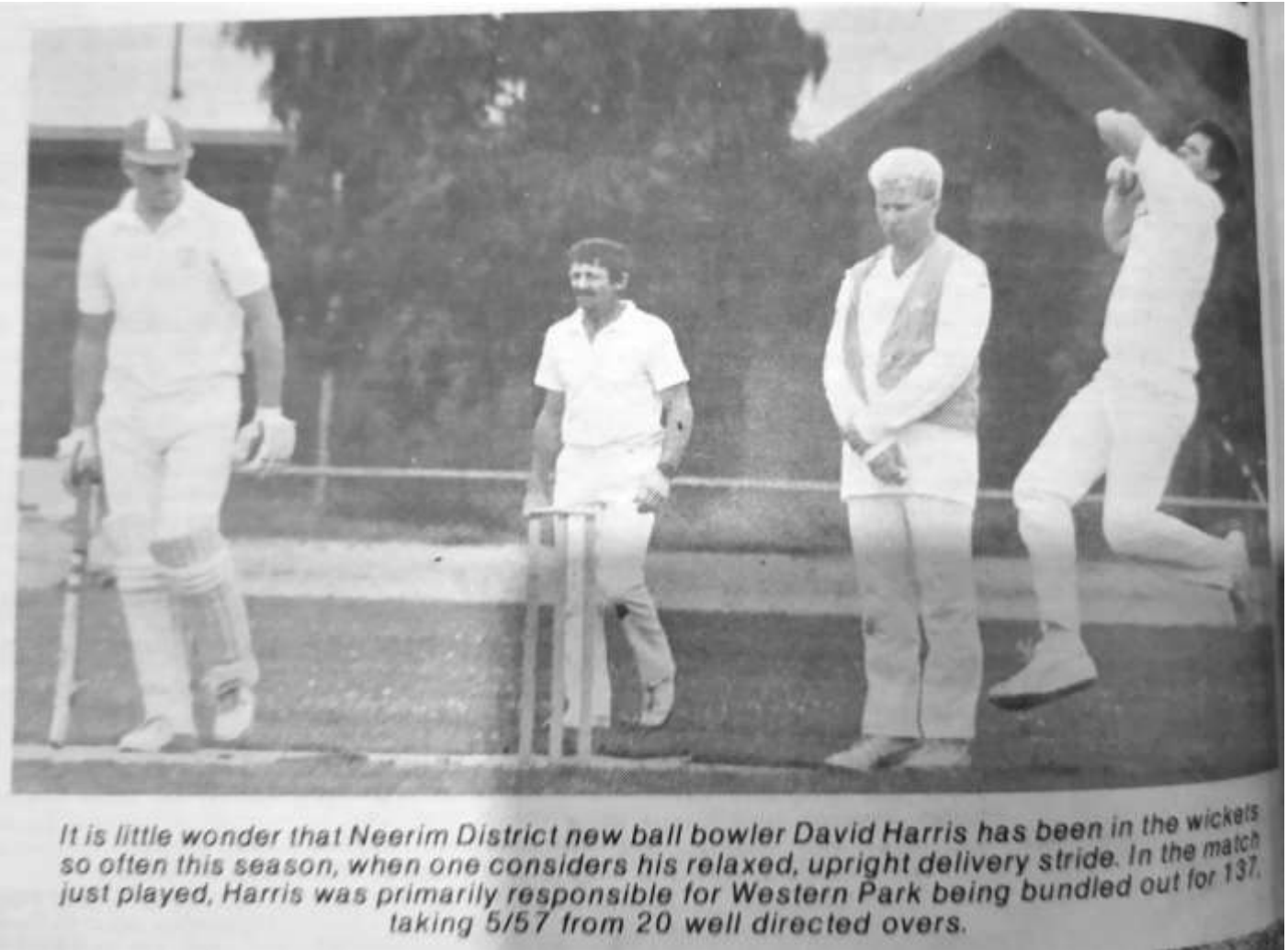

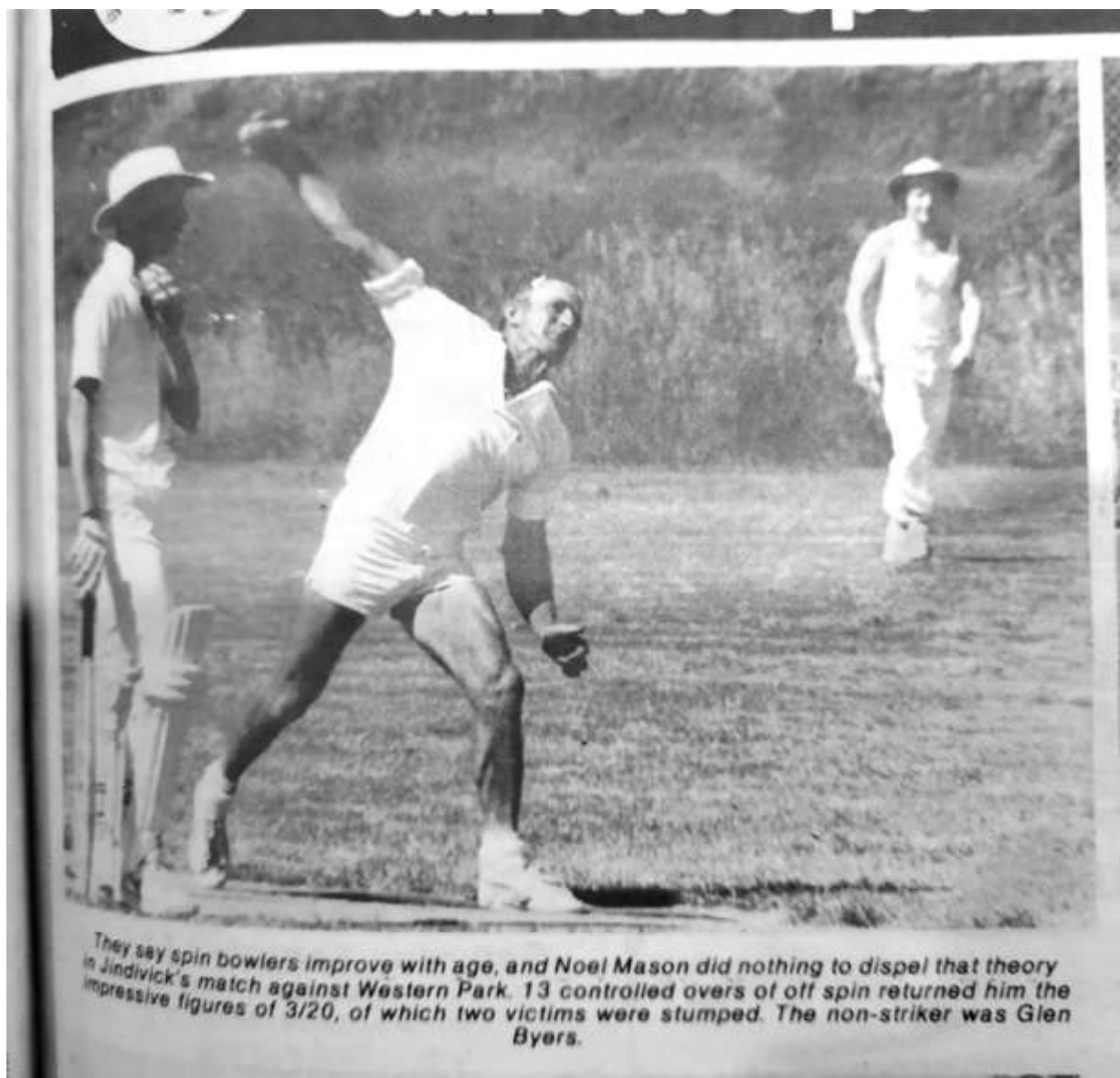
