Gar-Bun two in WDCA A-grade

Garfield-Bunyip will field two A grade teams in WDCA A-grade cricket this season.

Warragul has reverted to one and its second team will go back to B grade.

That means A grade will comprise 10 teams: Garfield-Bunyip has yet to decide whether to field two even sides or its best and then second best like Warragul did last season.

The Garfield-Bunyip decision is championship quality by the pace setters in the WDCA and winners last season of three premierships.

Eleven more players can now play A grade and that will make the powerful club even more powerful.

The grading committee has decided on 10 teams in A grade, C grade and D grade, 12 in B grade and six in a new C grade.

The season opens on October 5 with a two-day round.

Mr Kelvin Alger has settled in as new president with the additional duty of publicity officer to liaise between his 48 senior teams and the media representative.

DRAWS

Mr John Kane, secretary, hopes to have all draws completed this week and new treasurer Mr Michael Masterson already has a \$50 fine in the kitty imposed on a club at last week's annual meeting.

The WDCA has introduced three new sub-committees - advertising for the league booklet, social for official functions, and knock-out to organise this often abused money spinner with decorum this season.

Meetings will be held at the Warragul Club on the first Monday of each month for delegates of each club to meet on a more up-to-date basis.

The WDCA wants at least 10 umpires at \$30 a day to officiate at A grade matches and in finals. It has three at present.

JUNIORS

There are again 13 teams in the junior competition giving the WDCA an overall record 61 teams.

President is Mr Les Coster with Mr Bernie Gleeson secretary and main rule change is that batsmen must retire at 50 runs and

bowlers go off after 10 overs to give more batsmen a chance to excel.

However, there are circumstances when batsmen or bowlers return and face each other again after all others had their turn.

Western Park must beat Nilma-Dusties in the last WDCA A grade round to have any hope of being in the finals.

Even then, they need Warragul to beat Garfield-Bunyip to assist their cause over the next two Saturdays.

Ellinbank have to beat Longwarry in B grade and hope for a Jindivick win over Nilma-Dusties to make the grade on percentage.

Warragul's reasonable chance in C grade is to toss Nilma-Dusties and then eliminate the loser of Garfield-Bunyip v Hallora on percentage.

Key D grade matches are Hallora (top) v Drouin (3rd), Warragul Tech (2nd) v Garfield-Bunyip (6th) and Warragul API (5th) v Nilma-Dusties (4th). It's a great finish.

Western Park have to beat Ellinbank (2nd) outright to change the E grade four. Even they want Warragul Centrals (4th) beaten by Neerim District (3rd) to get in by a point.

C-Grade Captain's Report (by 'Bristle' from Western Park CC Annual Report)
