## How it started

**Western Park committee secretary Mr J. D. Johnson has provided background material in relation to the turf wicket controversy.**

He details a special meeting at Western Park Pavilion on Thursday, September 20.

Subject was the continued existence and/or reconstruction of the Western Park turf cricket pitch.

Mr Johnson reports that Western Park Cricket Club president, Mr A. Ross addressed the meeting.

He reported that the club members considered themselves insufficient in knowledge and experience to professionally administer a turf wicket pitch.

Mr R. Nuttall, W.P.C.C. delegate explained the past efforts to maintain the turf pitch.

He considered two factors had contributed to the poor condition of the wicket at present - insufficient foundations and the amount of traffic the oval endured during football seasons.

Western Park Cricket Club expressed the desire to continue with present venue.

Following discussion, it was unanimously decided that the following motion be presented.

T. Topalovic/R. Howard moved "that the W.P.M.C. seek permission from the Shire of Warragul to remove the turf wicket, that a synthetic pitch be installed by the W.P.C.C. (with assistance from the Shire) as quickly as possible to ensure W.P.C.C. usage for the coming season."

Motion carried unanimously.

The overall condition of the oval was then discussed. It was felt major attention was needed in the area of drainage.

Moved M. Jostlear/T. Topalovic "that the W.P.M.C. secretary contact the Shire Secretary, Mr Bruce Davidson, to arrange a deputation to the next Parks and Gardens Meeting to present the above matters."

Motion carried and meeting closed 9.33 pm.

# Western Park turf wicket

**The following letter from Western Park Management committee secretary Mr J. D. Johnson has reached our sports desk, as follows:**

Sir,  
May I as secretary of the Western Park Management express my disappointment concerning Mr C. Pierrehumbert's statements as reported by you in the Warragul Gazette (Oct 16th) re the Western Park turf wicket.

The Western Park Management Committee meeting Mr Pierrehumbert attended on October 11th 1984 was the committee's annual meeting where office bearers are elected for the ensuing 12 months along with appropriate general business. The decision on the turf wicket being only part of that business.

I felt distressed that Mr Pierrehumbert took it upon himself to release a press statement concerning the turf wicket decision when he was only in an observer capacity at the meeting, and therefore not qualified to comment on official business that has to be conveyed to the Shire Council - of which the W. P. M. C. is responsible and answerable to.

A joint press release would have been made after the appropriate bodies had been informed. To actually make public and criticize those people who voted against the motion is a lack of discretion from a man who has and holds office himself on the W. D. C. C.

As the playing surface at Western Park has had a troubled existence since its inception I wish to make these points:

- Since 1978 when the complex at Western Park was officially opened approx. only 18 games of cricket have been conducted due to poor conditions or delays

- That both football clubs waited nearly 3 years before a full season could be conducted

- That the turf wicket has been reconstructed twice with Shire money and help

- That the Western Park Cricket Club requested the W. P. M. C. to remove the wicket so cricket could be played as soon as possible with a synthetic wicket installed

- That the two football clubs were not represented at the annual meeting when the re-affirmation of the earlier recommendation was cast, therefore no pressure was on the committee's re-affirming stand

- That as far back as June 1977 the Shire Curator reported to the W. P. M. C. of the problems of maintenance associated with a turf wicket

- That after early interest, labour and funds by the W. D. C. A. their assistance in later years has waned to the degree where the leaders of the current W. P. C. C. feel incapable of the struggle to realise an effective turf wicket

- That the W. P. M. C. has held many long and

careful discussions on the turf wicket issue and it is no comfort to the W. P. M. C. to finally surrender the ideal of a turf wicket at Western Park.

Therefore I regard Mr Pierrehumbert's actions that of someone who has emotionally found the decision unacceptable.

May I add that I cast my vote for the retention of the turf wicket, so consider my reply impartial to the issue.

# One door shuts.. and another opens!

**Western Park has lost the Sri Lankan cricket match ... but has gained the VFL country practice match between Hawthorn and St Kilda in March.**

The Sri Lankans were to play a Zone 10 team at Western Park in February stymied by a decision to pull up the turf wicket that is expected to be endorsed by Warragul Shire at a council meeting tonight on the recommendation of the Western Park committee of management.

The management committee feels retaining the turf wicket until after the Sri Lankan match would reduce the time needed to prepare Western Parks playing surface for the new football season in 1985.

A synthetic pitch will replace the turf if council endorsement goes ahead as expected tonight.

Announcement that Western Park has been selected as venue for the Hawthorn - St Kilda match is therefore a bonus for Warragul and district.

Footscray will play Fitzroy in a match at Bairnsdale also as part of the VFL practice match series in country zones next year.

In another big football move announced at the weekend, former Maffra coach Graham Robbins will coach Latrobe Valley in next years Winfield VCFL championships with the backing of a special sub-committee of three.

Robbins takes over from Ken Robinson of Warragul who had the job for two years.

## TURF

And back to the Western Park turf, the Victorian Country Cricket League has now bought into the

controversy.

Zone 10 councillor Mr Barrie Wrigglesworth (Stratford) advises it is to ask two very pertinent questions.

• Why did the Warragul District Cricket Association apply to host the Sri Lankan match and not produce the goods?

• What did Western Park Cricket Club do with the \$1,250 (approved by the WDCA) given by the VCA towards the development of the Western Park turf wicket?

The VCCL intimates that it will hold an enquiry into

the matter with a view to getting its money back, or at least re-couping part of it.

The VCCL met last Friday night and Mr Wrigglesworth has contacted WDCA secretary Mr John Kane to notify him verbally of the League's actions to be confirmed in a letter.

The WDCA executive meets again on Monday November 5 when further light will be thrown on a rather embarrassing subject for all concerned.

## Australia's first four State country carnival

**Australia's first ever four State country cricket carnival will be played in Brisbane on January 21 to 27 next year.**

It's an expansion on the Victorian country team (captained by Robert Baldry) v Queensland country in Brisbane early this year.

Competing country States will be Queensland, Victoria, New South Wales and South Australia and each will play three games in eight days.

Format was approved at the VCCL meeting last Friday night.

It's part of what will be Australia's greatest boom cricket season with eight

countries competing in the World night series.

Country cricket will see some of the visitors in 12 topclass matches.

Sri Lanka will play in six country teams at leading centres Victoria will play England at Ballarat and Bendigo and Tasmania at Portland.

The Pakastaans will play a Zone team at Colac and the West Indies also play a couple of games in provincial cities.

# Kneebone hits Park into four!

The flashing bat of captain-coach Geoff Kneebone has hit Western Park into the WDCA A grade four.

His 132 not out on Saturday was a match winning effort against Trafalgar and it was also his second century this season.

Western Park, despite the loss of Country Week

bowler John Kane to Drouin and still under full strength, have edged out Ellinbank.

This is no mean feat because the Bankers downed defending pre-

miers Garfield-Bunyip after a magnificent stand by coach Bob Mason and football premiership coach Russell Pratt.

Still to be strengthened by the return of Statewide country junior Glen Ather-ton, Ellinbank and Western Park emerge as serious rivals to the top three — and a menace to Drouin who are still final's potential.

Keith Alger hit up 102 for Drouin against the weakened Neerim District attack and set the pace for a bid for outright points that just failed.

Warragul captain Michael Vick pulled off the catch of a decade against Buln Buln — claimed to equal the second slip scorcher by Tom Carroll for Drouin in 1969-70.

Fielding in the gully, Vick threw himself horizontally at a fierce square cut from burly Buln Buln right hander Brian Sell, making up four metres in flight to snatch the ball left handed and only inches off the ground.

The batsman, other fieldsmen and spectators stood dumbfounded for seconds before realising they had seen a dream catch.

Earlier in the day, Vick received a nasty blow in the neck trying to dodge a ball hit straight at him while fielding at short leg.

John Pierrehumbert also had a piece of the action with a score of 75 that included 12 boundaries, and eight were successive scoring shots, off the tight Warragul attack.

Dale Thompson retired hurt after making 100 for Hallora in D grade.

Three bowlers in minor grades took seven wickets, but no one in A grade made the honors list in a good day for batsmen. Stars were:

A-Grade Report (by Geoff Kneebone)

“At the beginning of the 1984/85 season, I had been with my previous club for a number of seasons and felt within myself that I could offer a little more to another club. The season drew closer, and it looked as though I would remain where I was, that was until I was approached by Western Park. I considered the proposition carefully and decided that with the youth and potential at the club a fantastic season would lie ahead. Well, this was not so. In fact, at the end of the 1984/85 season we remained in exactly the same position as the previous year, however we did manage to win seven games, losing four as compared to five wins the previous year. In previous years seven wins would certainly have placed a side in the finals.
